3. Principal's Report

a) i. 350 students in total registered. Number of students in classrooms are as follows: PP – 18, PP – 19, P – 22, P/1 – 22, Gr 1 – 22, Gr 2 – 21, Gr 2 – 22, Gr 3 – 26, Gr 3 – 27, Gr 3/4 – 26, Gr 4 – 26 Gr 4/5 – 25, Gr 5 – 26, Gr 6 – 24, Gr 6 – 25

ii. We have a YMCA - federal government employee - school settlement worker - working out of our school now on Mondays and Thursdays. She works with new to Canada permanent residents - will do lunch time programming - 20 or 40 students at the school. Some students have been here for a while who speak English. Some students don't have English etc. and they will be the priority.

There are 21 home languages at our school, which is a lot for only having 350 students.

b) *Vision Statement* - there is a staff and family version and a student version. It outlines the school's core values: Safety & Belonging, Kindness & Respect, Growth & Perseverance, Community & Responsibility, Curiosity & Lifelong Learning.

'At Springvale Elementary, you are safe, you are important, and you belong. We believe in you! You are here to learn, grow, be kind, and become the best version of yourself.
